

Sermon Title: Dancing With Wolves!

Scripture Reading: Matthew 10:16

1. We must learn to "dance with wolves" because Jesus has sent us among the wolves (Matthew 10:16). Share with your group on what is your personal response to this truth.
2. Discuss the identity and the characteristics of these wolves in the light of Matthew 7:15 and Acts 20:29-30. Have you met such wolves in your life and ministry?
3. Be as shrewd, discreet, circumspect as a snake. What does this mean for you in the marketplace? How does the illustrations of "Take the City Walk" and the William Wilberforce story help you to understand this concept? Do you have any personal illustration of this?
4. Be as "pure", or "innocent" as doves. Senior Pastor Lawrence Khong challenged us to live out this truth through:
 - (i) Genuine Integrity, and
 - (ii) Sincere Love for God, for each other, for the lost sheep and even for the wolves.Read also Romans 16:19 and Philippians 2:15. How do we do that and still be as shrewd as a serpent?
5. Share with each other some situations in your workplace which needs special prayer, and thereafter pray for one another.
