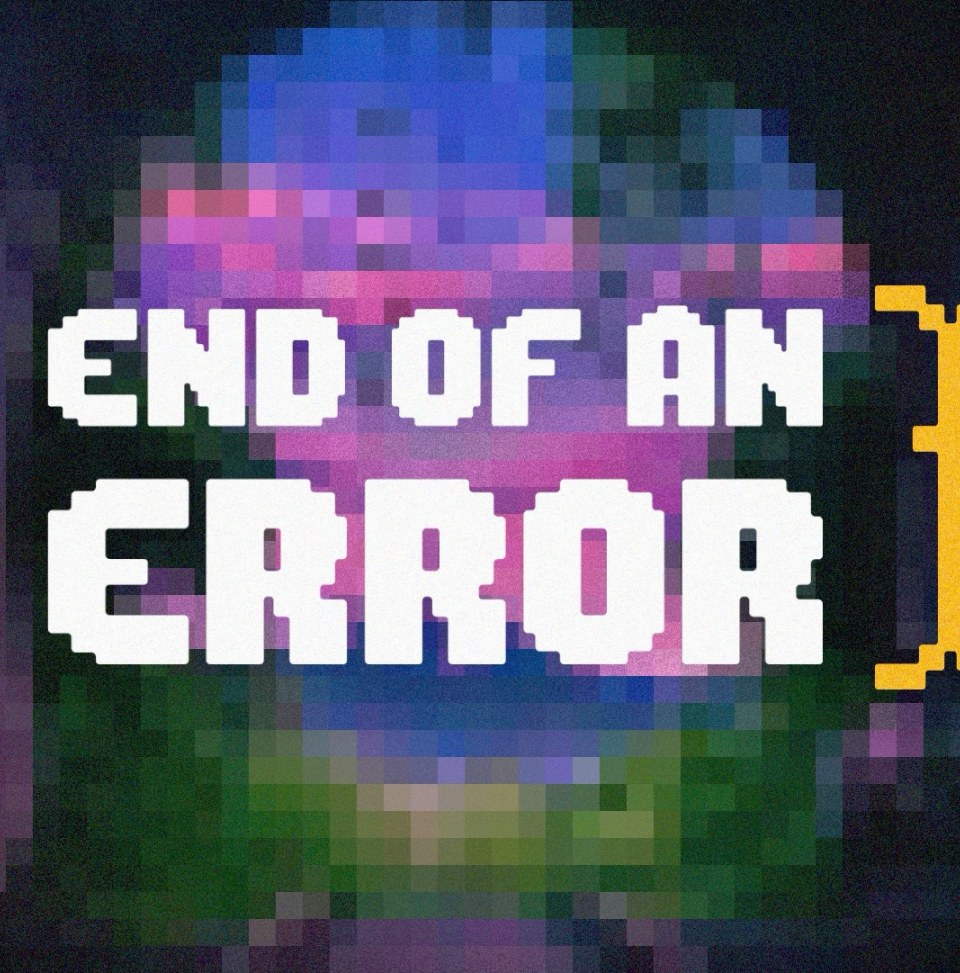

John 4:7-26 (NIV)

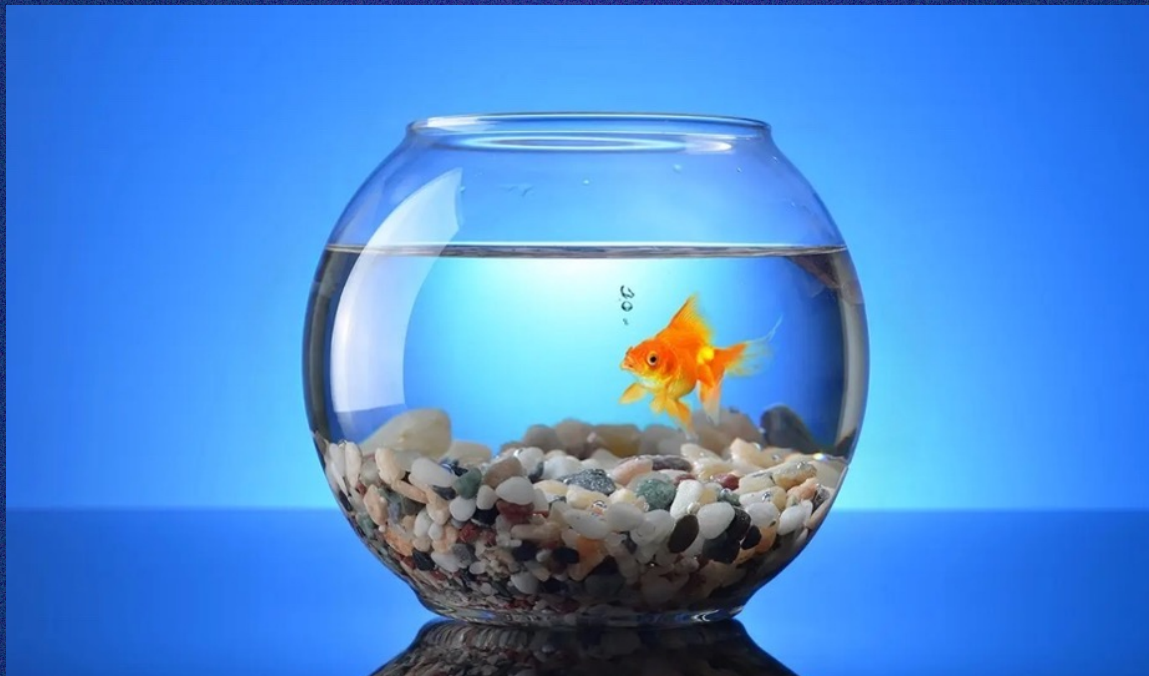
