Joshua 3:15-17 (NIVUK)

¹⁵ Now the Jordan is in flood all during harvest. Yet as soon as the priests who carried the ark reached the Jordan and their feet touched the water's edge,

Joshua 3:15-17 (NIVUK)

¹⁶ the water from upstream stopped flowing. It piled up in a heap a great distance away, at a town called Adam in the vicinity of Zarethan, while the water flowing down to the Sea of the Arabah (that is, the Dead Sea) was completely cut off. So the people crossed over opposite Jericho.

¹⁷ The priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the Lord stopped in the middle of the Jordan and stood on dry ground, while all Israel passed by until the whole nation had completed the crossing on dry ground.

Joshua 4:4-7 (NIVUK)

⁴ So Joshua called together the twelve men he had appointed from the Israelites, one from each tribe, ⁵ and said to them, 'Go over before the ark of the Lord your God into the middle of the Jordan. Each of you is to take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites,

Joshua 4:4-7 (NIVUK)

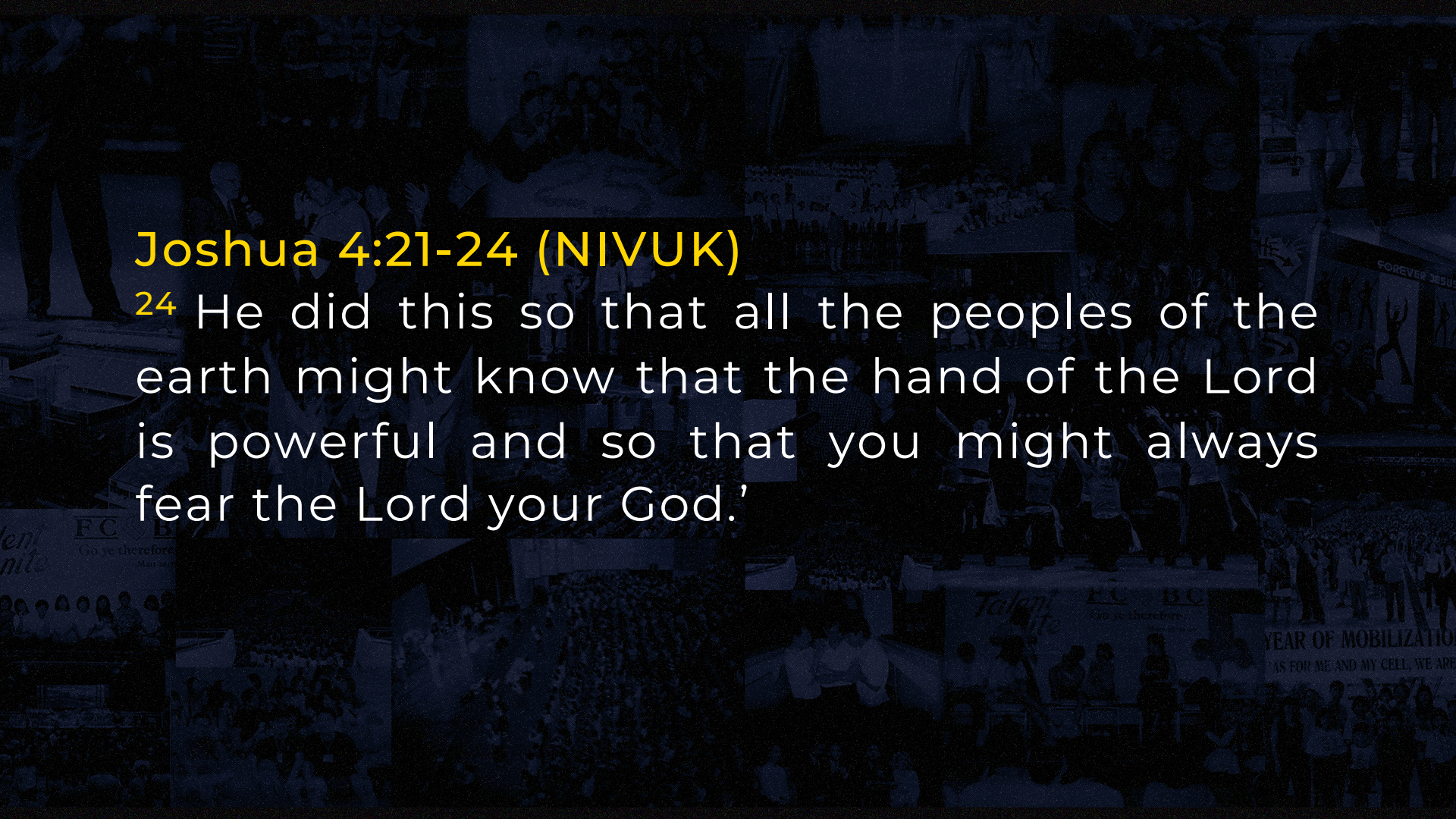
⁶ to serve as a sign among you. In the future, when your children ask you, “What do these stones mean?” ⁷ tell them that the flow of the Jordan was cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it crossed the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel for ever.’

Joshua 4:21-24 (NIVUK)

²¹ He said to the Israelites, 'In the future when your descendants ask their parents, "What do these stones mean?" ²² tell them, "Israel crossed the Jordan on dry ground."

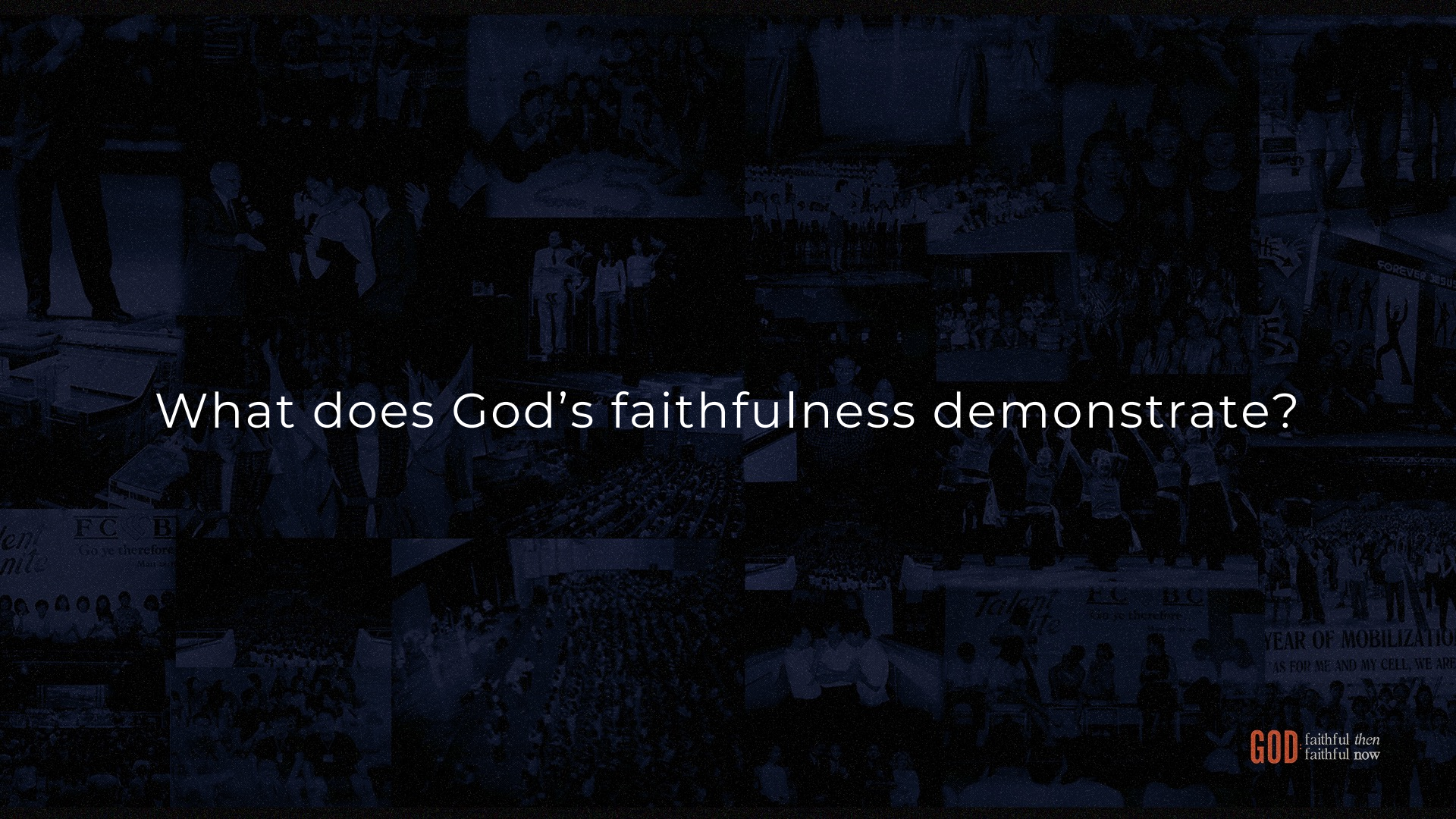

²⁰ After leaving Sukkoth they camped at Etham on the edge of the desert. ²¹ By day the Lord went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night. ²² **Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people.**

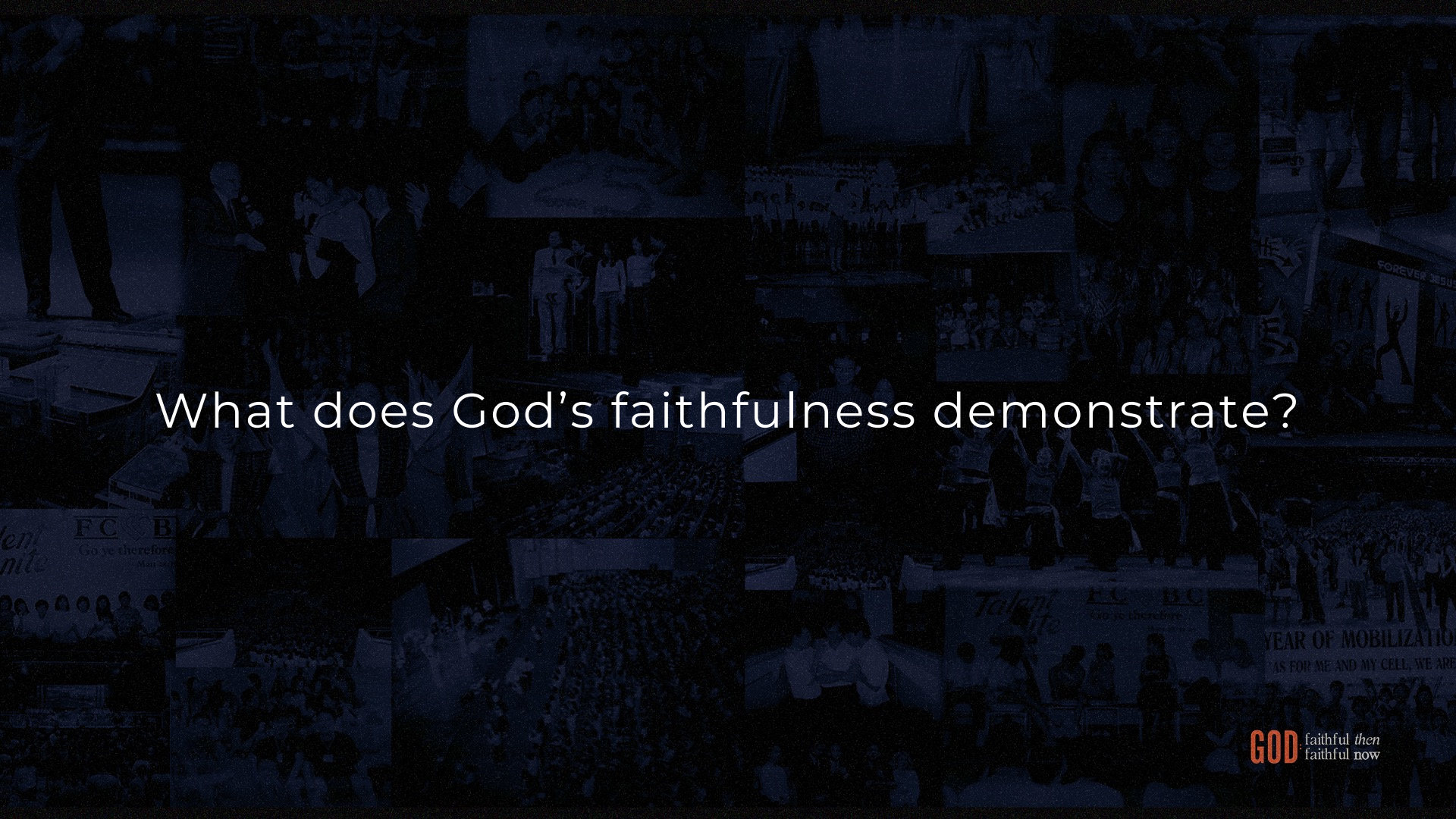

Exodus 14:19-22 (NIVUK)

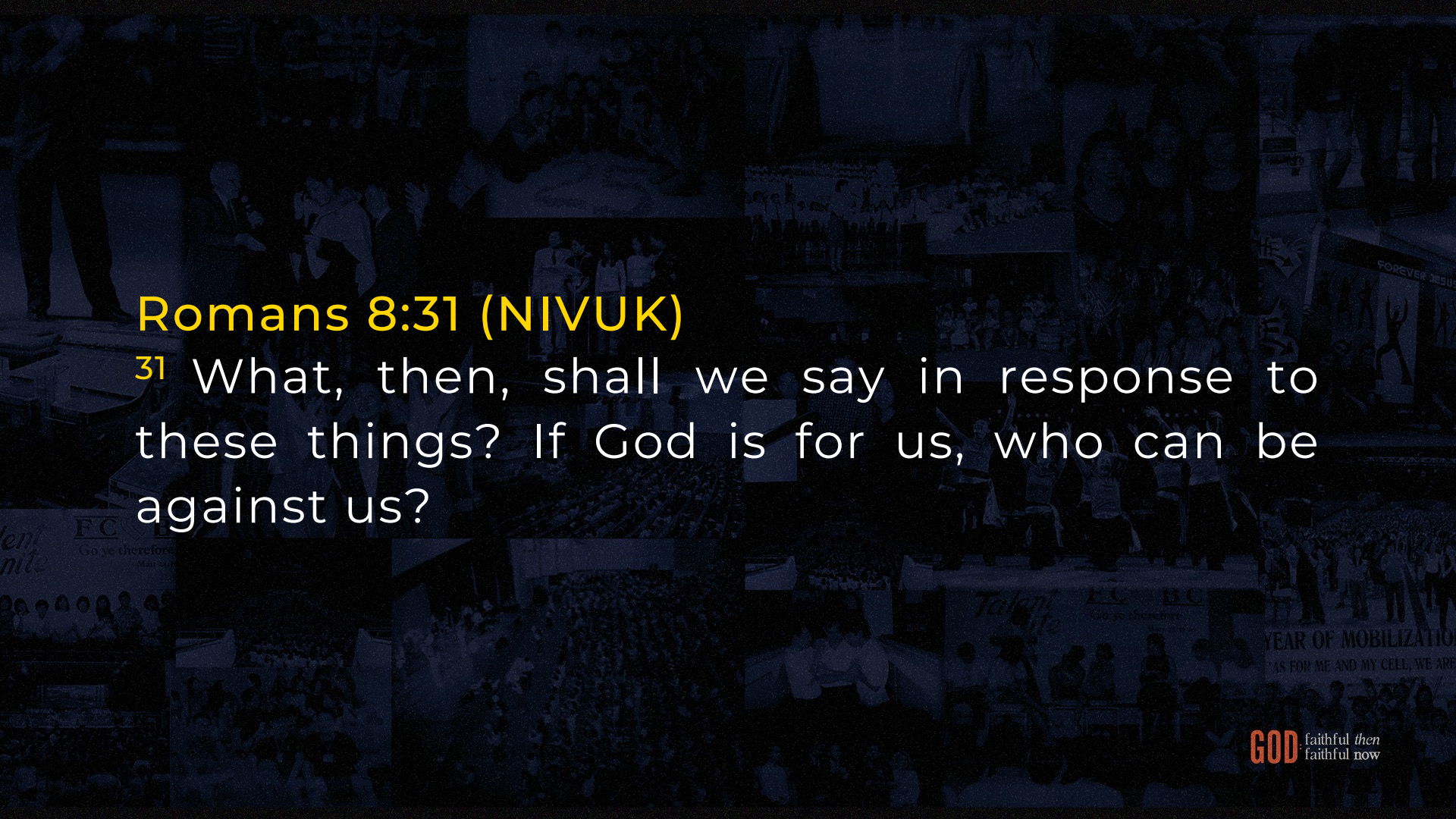

Joshua 6:1-5, 20 (NIVUK)

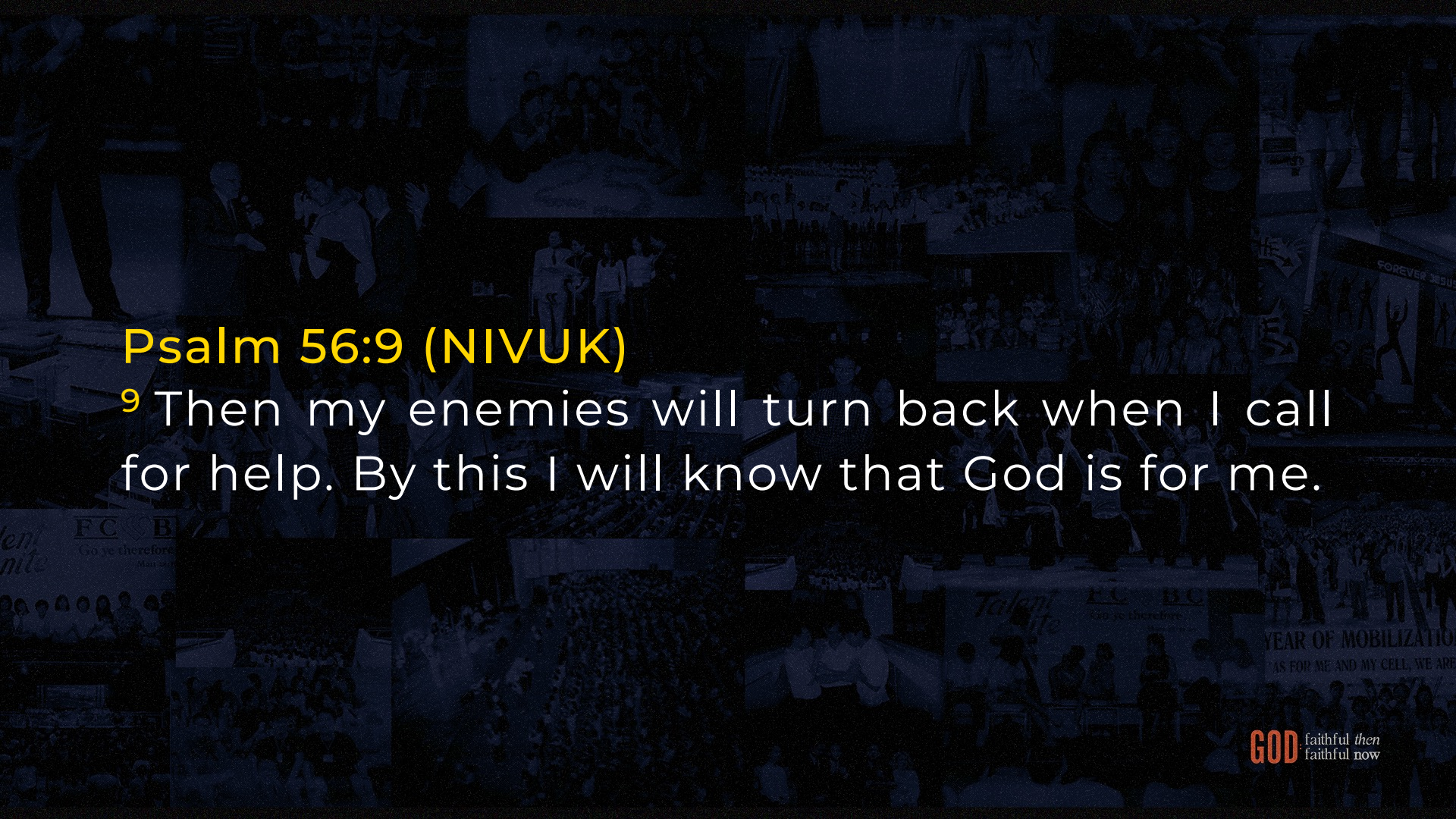

No one went out and no one came in. ² Then the Lord said to Joshua, 'See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men. ³ March round the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days.

Joshua 6:1-5, 20 (NIVUK)

⁴ Make seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march round the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. ⁵ When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, make the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse and the army will go up, everyone straight in.'

Joshua 6:1-5, 20 (NIVUK)

²⁰ When the trumpets sounded, the army shouted, and at the sound of the trumpet, when the men gave a loud shout, the wall collapsed; so everyone charged straight in, and they took the city.
