PRAYER CHAIN #1: KEEP PRAYING

As a family have a fun time praying, by taking turns to pray! Each person will take turns to pray one sentence about something or someone who needs God's power. Parents, you may need to model for your children and guide them along in how to pray.

For example, one round of prayer could be about your neighbour's family, with each person praying for a different need or person within the family. For each round, choose a different prayer topic or person.



PRAYER CHAIN #2: THERE'S POWER WHEN WE PRAY



Make a simple paper chain using strips of paper and tape, and secure it around the wrists of the person acting as Peter. Declare, "There's power when we pray to God!" and break free and tear off the chains!

REAL LIFE PRISON ESCAPE

Parents, tell your children about Brother Yun, the Heavenly Man, who also had a miraculous escape from prison in 1997, just like Peter.

Brother Yun was also put in prison for following Jesus. He escaped from the heavily guarded prison after many years there. He described how he heard the voice of the Holy Spirit, telling him to simply walk out the heavily guarded prison gate. Although there was a risk of being shot by the guards, he obeyed the voice, and walked straight through several prison doors that were somehow left open in front of many prison guards, across the prison yard and finally out of the main gate. Brother Yun said that it was as if he had become invisible to the guards who stared straight through him.
