for Toddlers & Pre-Schoolers



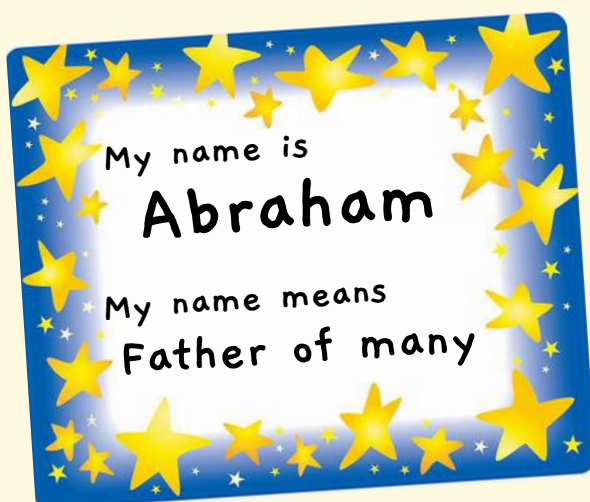
## 1) Starry Night

On a clear night, look out your window and try to count as many stars as you can. If it's cloudy, you can pull up a picture on your computer with a night sky of many stars.

Talk about how God promised to bless Abraham with a big family, more people than there are stars - and that He promised to love them.

## 2) God loves us & we love each other

Talk about the ways that God shows love to your family. Each person can share one way that they like to receive love from others in the family, and write them on a paper cut in the shape of a heart. Show love to each other that way this week.



## 3) What does my name mean?

Share with your child how you chose their name and what it means.

Using paper, markers and some tape, make a name tag with your child with their name and its meaning, so that they remember that their name was specially chosen for them. Wear the nametag at home all day!
