## GIFT HUNT

Isaac was a gift from God to his parents. Do a hunt around the house as a family and find things that are gifts from God. For example, a bed reminds us that God gives us sleep! Talk about how each thing is a gift and blessing, and thank Him for each gift He gave.

## BOUNCING BABIES

Whenever you see a baby this week, in books, videos or outside, talk with your child about God's gift to Abraham and Sarah - baby Isaac. Use it to remind them that God is faithful to answer promises. Pray about a promise that you are trusting God for as a family.

Tell your child a story about when they were a baby, maybe about when they were born. Affirm them that they are a gift from God to your family and that you are so happy to be their mummy and daddy. End with a great big kiss!



## YOUR FAMILY IS GOD'S GIFT

Each person in the family is a gift from God. Using craft materials at home, ask your child to make two cards - one for Mother's Day to appreciate their mummy, and another to show love to someone else in the family, telling them what they love about them.
