2. Latest Fashion In Paris

Sermon Title: More

Introduction

Discovery and Understanding Questions:

Q1. What does it mean when we say we are made for God's glory?

A1: Being made for God's glory implies that our existence is intended to fulfill the purpose for which God created us. This purpose revolves around being a blessing to others rather than merely seeking blessings for ourselves. The ultimate and most significant way we can fulfill this purpose is by sharing the gospel with others.

Q2. How does the mighty power of God empower us to do good works and accomplish even greater things for Him?

A2. Every believer is uniquely gifted by God for good works through the power of Holy Spirit, shaped by S.H.A.P.E.:

Spiritual Gifts: Given to us by the Holy Spirit to minister to others.

Heart: Godly ambitions, dreams, passions, and what you care deeply about.

Abilities: Natural talents.

Personality: Our unique thought patterns, feelings, and behaviors that distinguish us from others.

Experiences – Life lessons that help us mature, whether good or painful.

Application Questions

Break into smaller groups, share, pray and minister to one another.

- Q1. Share how you have been blessed by your fellow brothers and sisters in Christ.
- Q2. Share the changes you need to make in your prayers to God so that you can be used by Him for His glory.

Focus on edification, equipping and evangelism.
