

# V is for Voice



## Whose Voice is That?

Each person in your family will speak a sentence like “God loves you very much!” into the voice recording function in your phone. Parents, you will play each recording and have your child to identify who was the person who said that, by listening and recognizing the voice. Parents, you can ask your child how they were able to recognize different voices – for example Papa’s was deep and Mummy’s was gentle and their voice was excited! Ask them to describe how God’s voice would sound like. E.g., God’s voice is loving, big, warm.



## Listening Ears Craft and Listening Time


Have a time together with God as a family to listen to Him speak. Parents, you can prepare your child for that time by putting an extra big pair of listening ears to hear from God, using this craft!

After that, put on some quiet, slow worship music in the background and have a short time of listening to God.

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## Materials Needed


- 2 pieces of A4 Paper
- Pen / Pencil / Marker
- Tape / Glue
- Scissor
- Colour Pencil / Crayon



Create a headband by folding a A4 paper into half to form 2 strips of paper.



Write and design each strip of paper with the words "Listening for God" and "Samuel 3:10" verse respectively.



Draw and colour a pair of ear on a A4 paper. Cut out the ear outline.



Connect the strips of paper to the ear with tape. Wear this craft as you listen to God speak as a family.

## **Some simple steps to follow:**

- 1) Quieten down, you may even want to have your child lie down just like in David Club ministry time
- 2) Have your child to close their eyes and think about Jesus
- 3) Parents you can put your hand gently on their belly and pray over their spirit man (John 7:38 KJV) and ask the Holy Spirit to speak to your child
- 4) Listen to what Jesus has to say
- 5) Allow your child to share with you or draw it out
